On Saturday, July 15, CP Unlimited expanded its complimentary wheelchair clinics to the Hudson Valley, with an event at Carmel Volunteer Ambulance Corps.

We are so very happy to report that 28 people who use wheelchairs were able to take advantage of this service and received a full cleaning, sanitizing (for non-powered chairs), and a complete inspection to ensure proper functionality.

Each wheelchair clinic is an opportunity to meet new folks and provide a helpful service that increases personal independence and mobility. In turn, this means people who use wheelchairs are a more visible and integrative part of their local communities and allows them to achieve a fulfilling life.

PREVENTING A TRIPLEDEMIC THIS FALL & WINTER

To prevent a repeat of last winter's "tripledemic" of respiratory illnesses (Flu, COVID, RSV- Respiratory Syncytial Virus), everyone is encouraged to get vaccinated. What is new, however, is that the first RSV vaccine for use in persons 60 and over was recently approved by the Food and Drug Administration.

What does this mean to the CP community? Our residents are at particular risk and deserve maximum protection. Our staff also need to guard against these spreadable diseases.

We are in conversation about obtaining the new RSV vaccine. Senior staff are working on the logistics of identifying eligible residents, assuring permission is in place, and getting people to vaccination sites. Immunization starts in September and earlier is better! Plan on getting vaccinations in September and October.
