Recruiting Global Excellence for CP Unlimited



In response to staffing vacancies, CP Unlimited has innovated a new program to recruit qualified and interested individuals from around the world to join the organization, and the results are already paying off for our internal team and the people we support.

Two individuals hailing from Lagos, Nigeria have already received their H-1B Visas and are working with our people in Hudson Valley. They are gaining experience and knowledge about the people we support by working at our Mount Ebo Day Habilitation program in hopes that they will soon join the Residential team at our Watermelon ICF setting. Each comes to us with a four-year degree and experience working in healthcare settings so they join us as peers, ready to learn in our special settings.

Using a multi-platform approach, CP worked closely with colleges and employment agencies and channeled efforts into outreach events to cast the widest net. As a result, what was a stream will turn into a river as twenty-seven additional candidates have accepted offers of employment and are awaiting their H-1B Visa approvals. We are excited to welcome new team members from locales including the Philippines, Jamaica, and more from Nigeria.

We look forward to welcoming these new members of our team and celebrating our diverse workforce, united as one CP Family.

Mother Cabrini Health Foundation Awards CP Unlimited a \$IM Grant for 2023 to Expand Wheelchair Cleaning and Maintenance Events!







One component of our outreach efforts is an ongoing schedule of public wheelchair cleaning and maintenance sessions. These efforts were expanded in 2022 by a generous \$500K grant issued by the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation, allowing the Agency to offer more, and longer, sessions.

While initially targeted at servicing 200 individuals for the full year, we quickly found that the demand was even greater than expected—especially among military veterans. In just the first half of 2022, CP Unlimited had already surpassed the initial goal; by the end of the year CP will have completed enough evaluations to mark a 300% increase.

The result? More than 630 individuals were able to grow their independence and mobility, safely and with confidence.

Given the proven need—and our success—the Mother Cabrini Health Foundation magnified our grant, awarding CP Unlimited \$1M for 2023!

"It makes me proud to work for the most caring agency in the country. This grant is going to allow us to make a big difference in the lives of many individuals inside and outside of our community," said Paul DiGiovanni, Associate Director of Rehabilitation Services at CP Unlimited.

In addition to helping extend our outreach to veteran and disability-advocacy groups, the new grant will also enable the development of On the Move, a transformative mobility program for people who use wheelchairs. This means that our grant gets people moving like never before, using innovative methods, in a much larger geographic area!


