#### **Tuition Reimbursement Increase!**

Effective fall 2022, CP Unlimited will reimburse tuition costs up to \$2,000 per semester and up to a maximum of \$4,000 each year. Only courses related to your position will be considered for reimbursement. In order to be eligible for tuition assistance, you must be a non-union employee, employed on a full time basis and completed a minimum of six months of employment.
